# Annual Recap by Foundation Committee Chairs

### **Board Development**

Ms. Worden discussed updates including new members to the board and the success of the board retreat that was held in August. The topics discussed at the retreat included board expectations, fundamentals, and fundraising.

#### Executive

Mr. Pierne stated the executive committee continues to meet on a monthly basis.

### Finance and Investment

Mr. Abeles discussed updates for the finance and investment including the endowment.

#### Resource Development

Mr. Watson discussed updates for resource development including the college is at 27% of the goal as of mid-November. Employee giving is at 117%. There have been 6 endowed scholarships. Executive Director Whaley added there have been \$127,000 worth of gifts added since this report was printed.

# **Scholarship**

Ms. Hassinger said there have been \$2,469,953 awarded for 3,211 awards to 1,453 unique recipients since 2018. There are three types of awards: standard (making up 75% of awards), expanded (making up 4% of awards), and athletic (making up 20% of awards). Will be creating a scholarship to help students with additional funds relating to programs such as nursing, radiography, dental hygiene, etc.

# Update and Planning of the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tribute

Executive Director Whaley stated Dr. Klauber will be the host and HCC Athletes are to be honored at this year's tribute. The tribute will be hold on Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup> and invitations will be sent out in January. Since athletes will be honored, committee is looking into having a tailgating experience.
