El Camino Middle School: Completion of CSI

- El Camino MS was notified this year that for the 2023-2024 school year, they will be in the comprehensive support and improvement category (CSI) due to low achievement for student subgroups and received a grant total of \$165,090.
- For the 2023-2024 school year, ECMS worked with TNTP to build capacity around rigorous grade-level standard instruction, collaboration and using formative data to improve planning.

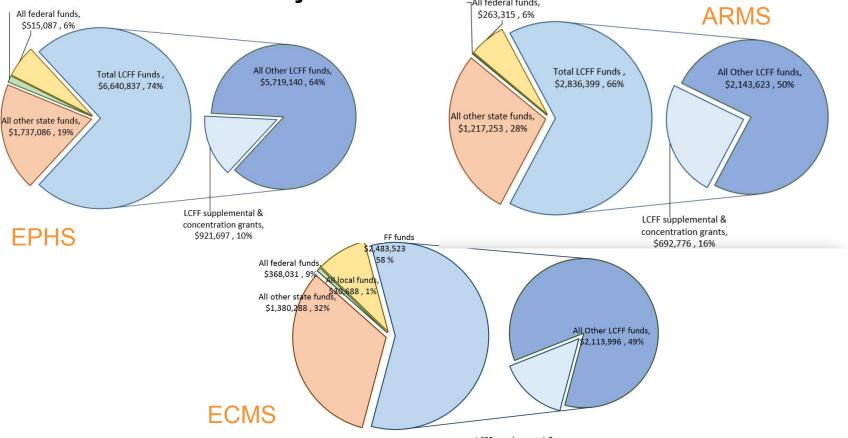
