## Bidding Process

Put out to bid: Commenced mid-February by Schipper Construction

## Status of:

Most of the bids are in with 2-3 bidder, unfortunately the high dollar bids such as the HVAC currently have one bid. Expanding the geographical area to include Ventura and Santa Maria and SLO to try to get more bidders. Speculating that the others who declined to bid did so for either resource/scheduling conflicts, might assume Smith is preferred contractor, or due to prevailing wage requirement.

## Upcoming Milestones

- a) Final cost estimate June 14, 2024 waiting for additional bids, but do have an estimate of what the cost will be.
- b) Upon completion of the bidding process, execute a contract with Schipper Construction – estimate mid June.
- c) Return of 2<sup>nd</sup> plan check from City of Goleta estimating June 30, 2024

## 4. Issues, Risks, and Concerns

#### Issue:

- a) Difficulty in getting bids for the major trades.
  - Impact: Potential delayed start if still trying to get bids after plan check completion and permits issued.
  - Action: Currently receiving bids for different parts of the job from local firms. Aswell
    as expanding the geographical area of vendors to included Ventura and Santa Maria
    SLO areas.

## Risks:

- a) Delayed starting estimating start of construction mid-July, 2024, There is a risk that the City of Goleta takes a long time to do the second plan check and issuing permits than the expected 30 days.
  - Mitigation: Not in our control.
- b) Completing the bidding process. Part of the biding process is to review and reconcile the material differences in the various bids. This process requires reviewing the details of each bid and reaching out to the various vendors and getting a response. This process also will entail locking in the vendors to the bids.
  - Mitigation: Currently has been addressed with the project manager and is in process of being resolved.

## **Concerns:**

- a) Logistical aspects of the construction. Where portable trailers and bathrooms will be located during the construction and the impact to the tenants.
  - Mitigation: Currently has been addressed with the project manager.

## 5. Comments and Recommendations

The project is progressing well and as expected, with all critical path activities on track. Regular monitoring and proactive issue resolution have been key to maintaining the schedule and budget. Continued focus on the bidding process and second plan submissions.
