Community Engagement and Feedback

Students

- Support students with school placements, if not EPHS. Have a school enrollment workshop. Ask other
 charter schools if they will extend their deadlines for enrollment. Ace, Alpha, KIPP, LCPA those with same
 mission and culture of belonging and safety.
- Work with advisors to give advice about closure and next steps, including transcripts, public school graduation requirements, etc.
- Make scholarships available to juniors and seniors.
- Provide transportation to EPHS.
- Provide shadow day for students going to EPHS
- Change F+s on transcripts for all ARHS students.
- Follow up on students after transfer next year to see how they are doing.
- Meet with students and families from ARMS.

Parents

- Form an ad hoc committee of parents to meet regularly with the school team to give advice about the transition & closure
- Provide information to middle school parents at ARMS
- Send any information in all ways: email, parent meetings, zoom meetings, text blasts
- Have clear information about graduation requirements for other schools
- Provide information other than EPHS
