

**CITY OF PRINCETON RESOLUTION NO. 23-54**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FOLLOWING POLICIES REQUIRED FOR THE SMALL CITIES DEVELOPMENT GRANT FOR THE SEVENTH AVENUE SANITARY SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT FOR THE CITY OF PRINCETON, MILLE LACS AND SHERBURNE COUNTIES, MINNESOTA**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Princeton has successfully applied for and received a Small Cities Development Program (SCDP) grant for the Seventh Avenue Sanitary Sewer Infrastructure project, and

**WHEREAS** The City Council approved the grant agreement (CDAP-21-0061-O-FY23) at the January 12, 2023 City Council meeting, and

**WHEREAS** the City is required to adopt the following policies and plans as a condition of the SCDP Grant funding, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota, hereby adopts the Residential Anti-Displacement Plan and attached hereto, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota, hereby adopts the Prohibition of Excessive Force Policy and attached hereto, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota, hereby adopts the Drug Free Workplace Policy and attached hereto, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota, hereby adopts a Fair Housing Plan that will post Fair Housing Posters (attached) on the Community Bulletin Board at the City Hall and on the city website, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota, hereby adopts the Section 3 Plan and attached hereto, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota, hereby adopts the Program Income & Local Income Reuse Plan and attached hereto, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Administrator be designated with authority to sign and enact the policies for the successful completion of the grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Princeton does hereby approve a resolution adopting the following policies required for the Small Cities Development Grant for the Seventh Avenue Sanitary Sewer Infrastructure Project for the City of Princeton, Mille Lacs and Sherburne Counties, Minnesota.
