SUBJECT: Approve updated “Ongoing Professional Practice Evaluation (OPPE) Specialty Specific indicators”, based on approved Crimson metrics as submitted by all Regions.

BACKGROUND

Required to periodically review and revise OPPE indicators based on quality metrics currently under track and trend to ensure metrics are rotating accordingly by specialty / department.

ACTION/PROJECT DESCRIPTION

As per The Joint Commission recommendations, the OPPE indicators for each specialty were reviewed by the appropriate Department Chiefs or representatives at each Region as well as approved through the C&Q and MEC committee process at all four Regions. The revised indicators are now specialty specific and are more meaningful and impactful to drive change in professional practices. Therefore, the Medical Staff at all Regions are requesting final approval by the Board of Commissions for implementation of the revised OPPE metrics based on current and updated practices at Broward Health. The proposed metrics have been uploaded to the Board portal.
