EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize a standard agreement (purchase order) with the Council for Opportunity in Education (COE) for a membership renewal and dues for FY2024-2025 for Developmental Education. Fiscal Impact: \$9,650.00.

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? The Council for Opportunity in Education (COE) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to furthering the expansion of college opportunities for low-income, first-generation students, and students with disabilities. Through its numerous membership services, the Council works in conjunction with colleges, universities, and agencies to help low-income students enter college and graduate. Over a million low-income students and students with disabilities each year receive college access and retention services through member colleges and agencies. Members gain access to Program and Professional Development opportunities, membership discounts for workshops, conference registration fees and technical assistance to ensure compliance with federal grant guidelines.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2 -6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. Membership dues, per the Florida

Statute 119. 01(3) requires that all financial, business and membership records held by the organization in relation to the individual(s) or organization(s) for whom a purchase order is being issued are to be considered public records and shall be subject to the provisions of Florida Statute 119.07.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting? N/A.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? FD200, CC0093, CC0626, CC0287, GLC:64502. Institutional Memberships and Sponsorships.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Yes.

Staff development/training provided by COE has allowed all TRIO programs at the college to adhere to legislation and regulations established by the Department of Education and TRIO. Training and information provided also help the programs establish programming to ensure that outcomes are being met and low income, first generation, and/or disabled students enrolled in the programs persist in school, graduate and/or transfer. Additionally, COE provides information to assist in the writing and submission of TRIO grants for funding.
