What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? Fire Boy Inspections Inc. will provide routine maintenance, annual inspection and recertification of fire extinguishers and fire suppression systems collegewide per the National Fire Protection Code during the FY2024-2025.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? \$10,000.01 up to Category Two (currently \$35,000.00) as defined in section 287.017(2), Florida Statutes. Facilities obtained three (3) quotes providing the best value for the required commodity or service. The award shall go to the lowest priced responsive/responsible vendor who meets the requirements per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34. The supplier selected is FireBoys Inspections Inc.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting? Yes, this vendor was part of the 2024/2025 budget for fire extinguisher inspections and system recertification..

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used?FD100, CC0145.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes, this vendor has been used to do routine maintenance and recertification for all the colleges fire extinguishers.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Yes, safety of our facilities by having up dated fire extinguishers.

# EXHIBIT "A" to Purchase Order STATEMENT OF WORK

### **Description of Services:**

FireBoys Inspections, Inc will provide in accordance with NFPA 10 (Standard for Portable Fire Extinguishers)

- 1. Confirm each fire extinguisher is visible, unobstructed, and in its designated location.
- 2. Verify the locking pin of the fire extinguisher is intact and the tamper seal is unbroken.
- 3. Examine the fire extinguisher for obvious physical damage, leakage, or a clogged nozzle.
- 4. Review the extinguisher placement, size, and type to ensure it is appropriate for the hazard area.
- 5. Determine the date manufacture of each fire extinguisher to provide guidance for replacement and hydrostatic testing.
- 6. Confirm the pressure gauge or indicator is in the operable range or position and lift the fire extinguisher to ensure it is full.
- 7. Make sure the operating instructions on the nameplate of the fire extinguisher are legible and facing outward.
- 8. Attach a new state certification tag along with a new tamper seal to each fire extinguisher inspected.
- 9. Replace and install all outdated and damaged fire extinguishers.
- 10. All work will be performed by a state licensed fire extinguisher inspector.

This service will be provided at all campuses and sites across Broward College properties during the month of expiration of the previous year's fire extinguisher certification to ensure that all fire extinguishers are in proper working condition in case of a fire emergency.

### **Total Consideration Payable for the Services:**

Compensation will not exceed \$35,000 (college-wide). It shall be paid to FireBoys Inspections, Inc. under the terms of this agreement.
