What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? Study Florida is a not-for-profit professional association comprised of regionally accredited, public and private, secondary schools or 2-year and 4-year, non-profit educational institutions located in the state of Florida. The broad purpose of this consortium is to connect international students with excellent educational opportunities in the State of Florida. Its primary goal is to promote and market Florida as a study destination for international students. The membership provides Broward College a presence (profile) in the consortia website and print magazine.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. Membership dues, per the Florida Statute 119.01(3) requires that all financial, business and membership records held by the organization in relation to the individual(s) or organization(s) for whom a purchase order is being issued are to be considered public records and shall be subject to the provision of Florida Statute 119.07.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? FD 100 / CC0171 / GLC:64502: Inst. Memberships and Sponsorships.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.
