- HIPAA Training
  - Providing privacy training at new employee orientation, during annual mandatories, and ad hoc as needed in response to privacy incidents.
  - Moving forward, aim to provide more proactive training in the hope of reducing privacy incidents.
- Look to implement privacy walkthroughs through the different regions
- Enhance auditing and monitoring
