## PURPOSE OF POLICY

To establish the local operating authority of the ~~College-District~~ Board of Trustees and the College President as Chief Executive Officer

## LOCAL LANGUAGE

Florida College System institutions are operated by local Boards of Trustees as provided in Florida Statutes [§FS 1001.63](#). The College President shall serve as the Executive Officer and Corporate Secretary to the Board of Trustees and shall be responsible to the Board of Trustees for setting the agenda for meetings of the Board of Trustees in consultation with the Board Chair. The President also serves as Chief Administrative Officer of Northwest Florida State College and all components of the institution. All aspects of its operation are responsible to the Board of Trustees through the President.

The name of the board of this College, which serves ~~the region~~ [Okaloosa and Walton Counties](#), is “The [District](#) Board of Trustees of Northwest Florida State College.”
