My sincerest apologies for the delay in getting back to you. I received your voicemail from Wednesday but I've been out of the office and am catching up on missed messages this morning.

It is great news to hear that University of Tulsa is looking to enroll New Hampshire students in the hybrid bachelor of nursing program! We hope the endeavor is fruitful, for the School of Nursing and for New Hampshire alike.

The form you are working with from the Office of Professional Licensure is somewhat dated in terms of the higher education approval section. There has not been an Office of Degree Authorization for a number of years, and the contact listed has not been a staff member at NHED for quite some time. I oversee higher education at this point, and I'm happy to confirm that the University of Tulsa is authorized to move forward with offering programs to students enrolled in New Hampshire based on NC-SARA policy pertaining to clinical reciprocity.
