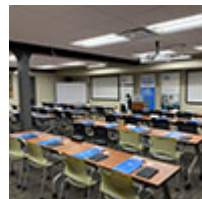

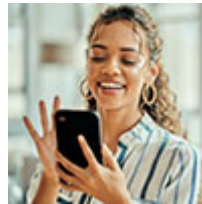
### Athletic Trainer Interstate Compact
