FRONT RANGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE: STRATEGIC PLAN AY 20-21¹ SNAPSHOT & EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

AY20-21 was an unusual year due to the pandemic, which impacted our students, our colleges, and our faculty. Nationwide trends saw severe enrollment losses among community colleges, especially for underserved populations such as low-income students and students of color. These losses may be reflected in the strategic plan metrics. Certificates and degrees awarded as well as transfers to 4-year institutions both declined over the prior year. However, FRCC exceeded in two of three concurrent enrollment metrics. College credentials awarded to concurrent enrollment students increased 11.9% and successful credit completion through concurrent enrollment increased 3.4%. The fall-to-fall retention for full-time students did not meet the national average and declined over the previous year. Distance and hybrid course pass rates increased slightly over the previous year but remained below the on-campus goal.

Equity indicators show that students of color and first generation students fall below the overall rate of students completing gateway English in their first year. These groups as well as Pell eligible also fall below the rate of completing gateway Math courses in their first year. These students consistently fall below the overall retention, course pass rate, and transfer rates. While the overall rate of precipitous decline in GPA from first to second semester decreased compared to last year, students of color, first generation and Pell eligible students were more likely to have a precipitous decline in GPA and to be registered at fall census but have no earned credits for the term. However, FRCC has made gains in some of these metrics. Credit accumulation in the first year has improved over the prior year for students of color, first generation, and Pell eligible students.
