

Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

I. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m., by Vice Chair Tom Kitson.

The State's Attorney's Office advised that one of the conditions drew an unnecessary legal conclusion and another condition was redundant because it was already required by the ordinance. These changes were presented to the committee.
- Katie White, Cathy Ferguson-Allen, and Jennifer Kolb briefly spoke to the committee regarding the Proposed Environmental Health Code changes that were moved to the County Board agenda during the County Services Committee earlier in the week.
