Re: SACSCOC Review of the Mission and Publication of Accreditation Status

Per Standard 4.2.a (Mission Review), as outlined in SACSCOC's Principles of Accreditation, the College's mission statement is presented for review. The current mission statement, developed as part of the strategic planning process, was approved by the Board of Trustees on January 21, 2021, and reads as follows:

“To improve lives by providing a high-quality, globally competitive education that is a catalyst for cultural, civic, and economic development throughout the region.”

Following guidelines provided in SACSCOC's Standard 14.1 (Publication of Accreditation Status), the College accurately represents its accreditation status and publishes the name, address, and telephone number of SACSCOC per SACSCOC's requirements and federal policy.
