Re: Collegiate High School Updates

This informational memo provides for updates from CHS regarding the upcoming 2022-2023 school year.

Since the last Governing Board meeting, the Florida Department of Education published the 2021-2022 School Grades and associated data, which shows how the Collegiate High School at Northwest Florida State College has performed as compared to other high schools across Okaloosa and Walton Counties.

Achievement data released by the Florida Department of Education shows the Collegiate High School ranked 1st among high schools in Okaloosa and Walton Counties in the following categories:

- 1st in English Language Arts Achievement
- 1st in Mathematics Achievement
- 1st in Social Studies Achievement
- 1st in Graduation Rate
- 1st in College and Career Acceleration

CHS has continued the tradition of being named an A+ school by the Florida Department of Education.

- CHS's Mathematics Achievement score rose from 79 to 88, a 9-percentage point increase from last year.
- CHS's Social Studies Achievement score held at 100% this year—a perfect score again.
- CHS remains a high-performing charter school this year.

CHS will have WOW weeks for students from August 8-19. A wide variety of activities includes safety training, student handbook overview, team building activities, tours of campus and other departments, robotics demonstrations, and summer-read projects.

CHS will host an Open House Wednesday, August 31 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Governing Board Members are invited to attend. The Open House will include tours of the new 9th grade program in building 300.

CHS will be joining other schools in Okaloosa County School District in implementing a new technology program that will include grading, scheduling, and a parent portal called FOCUS.

CHS Faculty and Student handbooks have been updated to reflect current NWFSC policies and Florida statutes.

- 112 12th graders
