The Goals of the Adult Learning Center

- Assist adults in increasing their basic educational skills.
- Offer quality educational opportunities to help students reach their goals through classes, tutoring, and/or online educational programs.
- Provide ESL classes for students seeking to improve their English reading, writing, and speaking skills.
- Offer SSL classes for adults seeking to learn how to speak, read, and write Spanish.
- Coordinate test proctoring services for students under various testing platforms and add testing platforms as needed.
- Organize and offer Citizenship classes for adults interested in becoming citizens.
- Collaborate with various community business/agencies to provide education or testing services as needed.
- Seek out, hire, and train Adult Education instructors and tutors.
- Celebrate student success!

2021 Highlights

- Quriss Romero was hired as Administrative Assistant: Student Services & ALC.
- Began using online learning software, Essential Education, for students to study for HiSET or GED tests virtually.
- Offered HiSET/GED classes for inmates at the Carbon County Jail. More individuals have been taking advantage of this service in the past 3 years: 2019 – 27 tests taken, 18 tests passed; 2020 – 29 tests taken, 22 tests passed; 2021 – 15 tests taken, 13 tests passed
- Increase in the number of Spanish speaking students taking the HiSET test in the past 3 years: 2019 – 3 students; 2020 – 3 students; 2021 – 6 students
- Co-facilitated our first Getting Ahead class
- This past year, I had the opportunity to witness a long time student (around 10 years) earning his high school equivalency through HiSET testing. This student had been working towards this for a very long time and faced some language barriers. I am very proud of his persistence and positive attitude.
- I am also proud of being a part of the creation of a testing center that offers such a wide variety of tests. I am happy that individuals in Wyoming do not have to travel out of state to take the tests they need for school, jobs, etc. We have even seen some testers travel from California and Canada to test in our center!

Overall, I am proud of being a part of CCHC. Through all of the transitions, we continue to work together to create a positive atmosphere for working and learning.
