What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? Library services provide critical instructional support materials/resource sharing, programs, events, research training and support for faculty and students, and a wide array of related services. Membership of the Florida Library Association as a service will assist with library staff and faculty development as well as meet the educational needs of the students. The financial responsibility of \$1,000 for the 2024 to 2025 year.
