What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? The purpose of this agreement is for Grandmaster Pianos to provide piano tuning services for two pianos in the Music Department on North Campus. The two pianos are used daily during general education courses (MUL2010 Music Appreciation) and individual student conferences. The instruments' quality of sound and availability impacts more than 350 students per semester. We do not have a piano tuner on staff at Broward College. Grandmaster Pianos has one of the best reputations for piano tuning in Broward County, and is frequently contracted with other piano sellers and movers in the area to tune upon delivery. Their quote is competitive and reflects the high quality of care they will take in preparing our pianos for everyday use in the classroom. Keeping our valuable instruments in good working order guarantees a best-in-class learning environment for our students.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00-\$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. One quote was obtained by the requesting department to identify the best value for the required commodity or service. No bid waiver used.
