What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? Performance fees for Rosemary Duffy Larson (RDL) Classical Series. This is a series of classical music concerts performed for the College community and the greater South Florida area. Students are exposed to performers of world-class caliber through use of a semi-endowed fund created expressly for the purpose. Annually over 600 students take advantage of this co-curricular experience.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? The procurement process for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used. There are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold.
