The professional development days included an Active Learning Institute (see below), an HLC Assurance Review Final Prep, faculty sessions on the CCSSE Survey and Assessment, training on reducing suicidal behaviors, D2L Organization and a main session for all employees that included new employee introductions, Employee of the Year Awards and a State of the College Address by President Mike White.

NJC Faculty attended a training session from Eric Salahub and Kerri Mitchell of Front Range Community College and the Active Learning Institute. The Colorado Community College System has made Active Learning Institute courses available to faculty across the system and the reviews of participating faculty from last semester convinced us that our entire faculty would benefit from this training.
