INFORMATION: In summer 2023, a sub-committee of WSU's Risk Management Advisory

Group (RMAG) reviewed WSU's health and safety regulations and drafted

proposed revisions to the chapter.

In addition to updating titles and wording throughout the chapter, the section on spectator safety was reworked extensively to be more systemoriented. The revision also adds express authority for security screening and video security systems at events and allows WSU to bar re-entry to events. Revisions to the clear bag policy provide University officials discretion regarding whether to apply the policy to smaller events and also include accommodations for medical and infant supplies.

The proposed revisions were presented to RMAG and the Risk Management Executive Committee in late summer 2023, and a rigorous internal review process was completed.

A public hearing on the proposed revisions was held on January 4, 2024. No oral or written comments were received. The proposed revisions were presented to the Regents as a future action item at the January 2024 meeting, with no changes since that time.
