SUBJECT: Approval to enter into Emergency Department call coverage agreements for vascular surgery services with compensation above the 90th percentile at BHN.

BACKGROUND

The District is requesting approval to enter into contractual agreements with compensation above the 90th percentile for vascular surgery call coverage in the Emergency Department at BHN. The region has documented and objectively determined there is a legitimate business purpose for qualified physicians to provide vascular surgery call coverage services.

ACTION/PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Broward Health is requesting that the Board of Commissioners of the North Broward Hospital District authorize the District to enter call coverage contracts with compensation above the 90th percentile for vascular surgery call coverage at BHN. A valuation report was completed by an independent third-party appraisal company which determined that the proposed arrangements are commercially reasonable, and the compensation is within fair market value.

JUSTIFICATION

The District has documented and objectively determined that there is a legitimate business purpose to continue to provide compensation for vascular surgery call coverage services at BHN. Hospitals are required under the Emergency Medical Treatment and Active Labor Act of 1986 (“EMTALA”) to provide evaluation of management of patients presenting to its Emergency Department. In accordance with EMTALA, BHN has a documented need to contract with the physicians and physician groups to provide unrestricted call coverage for patients presenting to the hospital’s Emergency Department.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Therefore, it is requested that the Board of Commissioners of the North Broward Hospital District authorize the District to enter into Emergency Department call coverage contracts with compensation above the 90th percentile for vascular surgery at Broward Health North.
