WHEREAS, the City Manager has prepared City Personnel Policy 10.35 – Employee COVID-19 Testing for Council review; and,

WHEREAS, City Personnel Policy 10.35 – Employee COVID-19 Testing has been reviewed by the City's legal counsel and the policy is consistent with current state and federal law; and,

WHEREAS, this policy is designed for use together with, and not as a substitute for, other COVID-19 prevention measures of the City; and,
