Utah System of Higher Education Workforce Preparedness & Alignment Study RFP #UU182220423

The effectiveness of the Utah System of Higher Education heavily relies on its ability to produce graduates equipped with the skills and knowledge needed by employers. By assessing the performance and capabilities of our graduates from the perspective of employers, we can gain valuable insights into areas of improvement and/or sustainment.

A third-party consultant will perform a statewide study of graduates produced by the Utah System of Higher Education at the Technical College and undergraduate level focused on Utah employers. This comprehensive study will assess the effectiveness of higher education graduates in the workforce, with specific focus on gathering insights from employers in key industries. This study will help identify areas of improvement and/or sustainment and will provide recommendations for enhancing higher education's responsiveness and alignment with the needs of employers in Utah to inform strategic decisions within the Utah System of Higher Education.

Talent Ready Utah led a Steering Committee to select a consultant to perform the study. Two consultants made it to written and oral scoring, which assessed the consultant's ability to perform the study. After scoring the proposals with robust conversations, Cicero Group was selected to perform the study based on the cumulative score and budget. The cost of the study will be \$128,060.
