Dear Valued Customer,

Inflations, the Covid 19 pandemic and the war in Ukraine have created global supply chain disturbances. Shipment dates are unreliable and lead-times and costs are increasing. Unemployment has dropped to pre-pandemic levels resulting in tight talent availability.

As your partner, we want to provide transparency around the potential impact to project and service work which could include:

- Extended material lead times negatively impact our ability to meet desired schedules.
- Material availability extending project completion dates.
- Quote requiring review when pricing is over 30 days old to align with current material costs that could result in a project cost changes.
- Talent availability may push out schedules.

CEC is focused on mitigating these effects for you through these initiatives.

- Close engagement with suppliers on forecasts, lead-times, and costs impacts.
- Advanced equipment ordering within 30 days of proposal acceptance is available, when down payment requirements are met, to mitigate price increases if supplier prices at purchase order versus shipment date.
- Qualifying additional and new suppliers.
- Increased purchase commitments to suppliers to secure supply on critical components.

Conditions & Clarifications:

• Customer to provide for the secure temporary storage of equipment and cable during the project



installation. In the event that adequate storage space is not available for CEC provided system equipment and/or cable, CEC will assess a storage fee of \$150 per month for the duration of the project.

- Additional CAD time due to customer requested drawing updates or individual AHJ specific requirements will be included in a billable change order. In the event that up-to-date CAD (dwg) files are not made available to CEC, a billable change order will be provided to account for the CAD labor required to create the floor plans of the project.
- NOTICE: All work performed by CEC MUST be scheduled through our Project Management Office (PMO), allowing adequate lead time for equipment delivery and scheduling of workforce. Upon receiving project PO our PMO will contact you to confirm project timelines and availability of resources. Standard lead time for labor services is 4 to 6 weeks from confirmation.
- Designate a single key customer representative to act as project manager and approve completed work
- All CEC labor is to be performed during normal CEC business hours (excluding holidays) unless otherwise specified. Customer is to inform CEC prior project start up, of any times when work cannot be performed.
- This proposal includes travel to and from the site to perform our stated scope of work. Delays incurred by CEC
 employees and their subcontractors due to escorts, clearances, inability to enter workspace, and other factors beyond
 our control will be invoiced at our current labor rates.
- Proposal is based on Single Phase Completion of the project. If for any reason the work is to be delivered in multiple phases, additional charges will be incurred.
- Equipment items included in this proposal are based on the current model as detailed in the equipment list or in the project submittal. Changes due to discontinuation of product by the manufacturer may be subject to a change in project price.
- Any changes to this proposal will be communicated and approved in writing by an authorized customer representative prior to commencing work.
- Any installation schedules that require expedited equipment delivery will incur additional charges.
- Warranty shall begin on the date of beneficial use, or the project close out, whichever comes first. Said warranty is for equipment installed under this project and warranty does not extend to existing equipment. Standard warranty work is performed during normal CEC business hours.
- It is assumed that any existing equipment and cable used in the new system is in good operational condition. Any deficiencies found will be brought to the customer's attention, and replaced or repaired at additional cost. Any additional repairs or assessments may be done on a T&M basis at the customers written request.
