COMMUNITY

Use of the Rec Hall during this period included: A Community Health Fair and a 2-day Saint Paul Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy community discussion. Through the Community Arts Partnership Project grants, the City was able to bring up Ben Weiland, director and editor of Island X, and the pro surfers, to hold workshops on filming and surfing as well as host a showing of Island X with Q&A. The participants had a great time learning the basics of surfing at Peer Point. The video from the film workshop will be shared with Talkeetna youth, through Zoom, after they complete the workshops. There is an Aleut Independence celebration planned for October 28th. The Public Health Nurse and team will be on island November 6th and plan to host a community meet and greet.

HOUSING
