WHEREAS:	Minnesota State Statute 204B.45 authorizes "mail balloting" for a city or township located outside of the Seven County Metropolitan area having fewer than 400 registered voters, or a precinct that has fewer than 100 registered voters; and
WHEREAS:	On January 14 th , 2016, Resolution 16-02 The City of Princeton Approved Mail Balloting for Princeton Residents that were located in Sherburne County, which is considered Precinct 2
WHEREAS:	On July 22, 2021 the Princeton City Council approved an annexation request for 3 properties, which include approximately 240 residents which are located in Precinct 2
WHEREAS:	with the addition of the recently annexed property, City of Princeton Precinct 2 will now have more than 100 registered voters; which no longer meets the requirement of mail balloting in Mn Statute 204B.45
WHEREAS:	The City will notify all registered voters in the City of Princeton, Precinct 2, that they will vote at the Depot effective for the 2022 election cycle.
