SUBJECT: Approval to renew a two-year employment agreement with compensation up to the 84th percentile with Dr. Celso Agner to provide Interventional Neurology Services at Broward Health Medical Center.

BACKGROUND

The North Broward Hospital District, d/b/a Broward Health is seeking to renew a two-year employment agreement with total maximum compensation up to the 84th percentile with Dr. Celso Agner. Dr. Agner is a doctor of medicine, having received a medical degree from the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Sao Paulo in Sao Paulo, Brazil in 1993. He completed a residency in Neurology at Albany Medical Center in Albany, New York in 2003, a fellowship in Neurological Critical Care/ Stroke at Albany Medical Center in Albany, New York in 2004, a fellowship in Neuroendovascular Surgery at Albany Medical Center in Albany, New York in 2006, and a visiting fellowship in Interventional Neurology at the Medical College of Wisconsin in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 2010. Dr. Agner is board certified in Neurology and Vascular Neurology and has obtained and currently maintains an unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Florida.

It is critical for the community and healthcare system to employ Interventional Neurology specialists to meet the current and future growing demands. As a safety net hospital, the District is obligated to provide services to meet the community needs.

ACTION/PROJECT DESCRIPTION

We are requesting the Board of Commissioners to approve renewing a two-year contract with Dr. Celso Agner with compensation up to the 84th percentile.

Broward Health is requesting that the Board of Commissioners authorize the District to renew a new agreement with Dr. Celso Agner, for a two-year term. An independent third-party appraisal report determined that the proposed arrangement is commercially reasonable, and the compensation is within fair market value (FMV).

FINANCIAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT

The proposed salary is budgeted for FY 23.

JUSTIFICATION

Broward Health has documented and objectively determined that there is a legitimate business purpose for the services of a qualified neurology specialist to provide clinical care at Broward Health Medical Center. As a safety net hospital, the District is obligated to provide services to meet the community needs.

According to the Community Needs Assessment, there is a documented need of 14.8 neurology specialists at Broward Health Medical Center by 2025. Recommendations from the Community Needs Assessment suggest that access to care is a priority and specifically a need to enhance access to specialists throughout the service area.

Dr. Agner will continue to provide Interventional Neurology services to meet community and healthcare system needs.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Therefore, it is requested that the Board of Commissioners of the North Broward Hospital District authorize the District to renew a two-year employment agreement with compensation up to the 84th percentile with Dr. Celso Agner to provide Interventional Neurology Services at Broward Health Medical Center.
