The 2020 National Electrical Code is being published and will be distributed throughout the country. The NH

Electricians' Board is accepting inquiries from prospective continuing education providers for approval by the

Electricians' Licensing Board to teach the 2020 NEC code changes.

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- 2. Providers shall submit, in writing, to the Electricians' Licensing Board all scheduled 15-hour code courses with the time, date, and address where course will be held. (It's a possibility a Board member representative could attend to monitor the course.)
- 3. Attendance shall to be taken three times during the scheduled day ... at the beginning of the day, after lunch break, and at the end of the day. Picture ID and Electrician's license are required for proof at registration and for proof of course completion before certificate is issued.
- 4. Classes must start and end at the scheduled time. Breaks and lunchtime are not considered part of the 15 hour class time.
- 5. One of the fifteen hours must include changes to RSA 319, the Administrative Rules, and to the list of 'Commonly Found Licensing Concerns and Installation Deficiencies' provided by the Electricians' Licensing Board.

RSA 319-C, Administrative Rules and the list of 'Commonly Found Licensing Concerns and Installation Deficiencies' can be found on the NH Electricians' Board web site.

The Electricians' Board is going to continue the requirement for providers to submit the names of course attendees with New Hampshire licenses electronically. As in the 2014 cycle, we will not accept certificates as proof of continuing education for actual license renewal.

Once applications for new providers are approved the provider will receive a test packet and instructions for the electronic submittal. A provider number will be issued when the test submittal is received. Previously approved providers must acquire Board approval each code cycle.

I Started out in the electrical industry with LONGCHAMPS ELECTRIC Inc in 1983 thru 1989 during which I enrolled in the ABC program for NH apprenticeship. During this time at LONGCHAMPS ELECTRIC I worked in industrial, commercial, residential, and service work. During this time, I left MST as an instructor and started to instruct electrical apprenticeship training in Dover, and in Manchester for NH MECHANICAL TRADES SCHOOL for years 2-3-4.

From 2017 to the present, I have been performing electrical inspection, training and consulting under JP ELECTRICAL ENTERPRISES.
