Northeastern Junior College is super proud to announce that we had 19 out of 20 nursing graduates from May 2023 pass the NCLEX on their first try – 95 percent! NCLEX is the national exam that nursing school graduates must take to become registered nurses. State Board of Nursing maintain nursing school's accreditation based on the percentage of students first take of the exam. Every nursing school's graduating classes must not fall below an 80 percent in passing their first attempt of the NCLEX.

Northeastern's Phi Theta Kappa Chapter once again participated in the Operation Christmas Child by collecting donations to build over 80 shoeboxes for children in third world countries.

The NJC Associated Student Government sponsored a Mentalist Show on November 2.




The NJC Theatre Club held an 80's themed murder mystery party on November 2! It was night of an electrifying night of drama, suspense, and nostalgia


