## Summary of Key Observations/Recommendations

University Regulation UCF-4.029 governs the use of university facilities and grounds for events, including expressive activities, demonstrations, and protests. The regulation is amended to:

- add new language to section (5)(c), which articulates conditions for persons or groups when
  using university facilities and grounds. Specifically, language is added to prohibit persons
  from: restricting the movement of others; wearing items to conceal identity under certain
  circumstances; and refusing to provide identification when requested by a university official
  or law enforcement official in the course of their duties.
- specifying outdoor use spaces on the downtown campus (section (7)),
- adding additional clarification related to signage and displays in connection with events (section (5)(a)), and
- making small corrections elsewhere in the regulation.

## **Additional Background**

This regulation was last amended on June 25, 2024.

### **Implementation Plan**

The amended regulation will take effect upon approval by the UCF Board of Trustees.

#### **Resource Considerations**

The proposed regulation amendments are not anticipated to incur additional costs to the University.
