



FUND HISTORY

- The James W. and Carolyn M. Sutherland Fund was established in 1974 with a gift of \$49,963 to the Trustees of the Endowment Association of William & Mary College
- Richard Bland College Foundation was not established at the time of the Sutherland gift (incorporated as a non-profit in 1977)
- The use of the Funds are restricted to support Richard Bland College
- As of June 30, 2023, the market value of the Fund is \$468,395
- Over the past 50 years, the College has withdrawn funds only 4 times:
 Faculty dental insurance plan
 Website development
 Barn Theater renovation
 Capital campaign feasibility study
- The College has reinvested the Fund's income rather than withdrawn funds on an annual basis


