TOPIC: Board Policy 9-72, Transfer Credits from Area Technical Colleges

RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN: Transform the Student Experience;
Create Education without Barriers through Transformational Partnerships

EXPLANATION: This past academic year System leadership held monthly meetings with Emily Griffith Technical College (EGTC) about strengthening our partnership and improving pathways for EGTC students to transfer to CCCS colleges. As a result of these conversations, System staff updated Board Policy (BP) 9-72 and System Procedure (SP) 9-72 to reflect our commitment to partnering with EGTC and other Area Technical Colleges.

The BP and SP provide guidance for the transfer of career and technical education post-secondary credits from Area Technical Colleges to CCCS colleges. Specifically, CCCS institutions will accept all post-secondary credit in transfer from students who have attended any of the three Area Technical Colleges in Colorado. Furthermore, those credits earned with a “C” or better may apply to any associates degree, not just Associate of Applied Science degrees.

RECOMMENDATION: CCCS Staff recommends the Board approve the revisions to Board Policy BP 9-72.
