Dear Mayor Walker and the Princeton City Council,

Thank you for contacting me in support of a special legislative session to finish important work. I appreciate your insight into how these bills would benefit the City of Princeton and agree completely.

As you know, in mid-May a session-ending budget framework was agreed to and signed by me, Senate Majority Leader Miller, and Governor Walz to cut taxes for workers and families; and invest in people and communities. In addition, key federal infrastructure funds would have been accessed in several bills.

When the constitutionally mandated May 23rd adjournment date was reached without consensus on several bills, the House DFL and Governor Walz remained ready to work, compromise, and finish up this important work in a special session. Unfortunately, Senate Republicans walked away from the negotiations. We are still ready to take action, but as of this writing Senate Republicans remain firm in their opposition.

My DFL colleagues and I believe we should return and pass the largest tax cut in state history, key investments in K-12 education, a bonding bill that will improve our infrastructure, matching state funds to access billions of dollars in federal infrastructure funds, and crucial investments in nursing homes, child care, public safety, and housing. As the Speaker of the House, I will continue to urge Senate Republicans to return to the table and join us in finishing the work to help Minnesotans.
