**RE:** Resolution 24-15 – A Resolution Authorizing a Cost of Living Adjustment for City

Employees Employed in 2025

**SUMMARY:** Resolution 24-15 approves a 2.5% COLA for each employee that is employed with the City of Saint Paul as of January 1, 2025.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:** On December 15, 2022, the City Council approved a 6% COLA for each employee employed with the City as of January 1, 2023.

**BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:** City Personnel Policy 3.11, Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) requires the City Council to approve a Cost of Living Adjustment. The federal COLA for 2025 was approved at 2.5%. Given the City's financial situation a COLA greater than the federal COLA is not recommended.

**ALTERNATIVES:** Council could choose not to approve this resolution.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:** A COLA of 2.5% will not require any adjustments in utility rates.

**ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATION:** Administration recommends approval of this resolution.
