A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING A TOTAL PRELIMINARY PROPOSED TAX LEVY AND DESIGNATING A PUBLIC INPUT MEETING

- WHEREAS, the City must conform to the timetable the State has adopted for the "Truth in Taxation" procedure; and
- WHEREAS, the City has received certification from the State of the Local Government Aids; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Princeton City Council that a preliminary proposed operating budget of \$5,833,321 be set for the General Fund in Calendar year 2025.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Princeton is hereby certifying a total preliminary proposed tax levy for the current year, collectible in 2025, of \$3,697,223 comprised of the following levies:
