Re: Indemnification Agreement, Joint Powers Board to Amend Airport Zoning Ordinance

Dear Mr. Swanson:

The City of Princeton received the referenced indemnification agreement; it appears to be a condition of the Township's participation in the Joint Powers Board to amend the City of Princeton's Airport Zoning Ordinance.

The proposed amendment is to solely remove a single item, that of the cross-wind runway. We expect this work to have a duration of 60 to 90 days with little liability or impact to the Township. In fact, elimination of the cross-wind runway will benefit Township property owners located west of the airport by eliminating development restrictions caused by the safety zones of the runway.

Given the above stated facts, the City of Princeton will not be signing the indemnification agreement.
