As the founder and Executive Director of Ruff Start Rescue here in Princeton, I wanted to reach out about a program that would benefit both Ruff Start Rescue and the Princeton community. The BETTER CITIES FOR PETS™ program helps cities, like Princeton, be pet-friendly so more people can enjoy the benefits of a life with pets. It was created by Mars Petcare and includes a playbook, an assessment tool, a city certification program, and free online resources.

Becoming a BETTER CITIES FOR PETS™ Certified City shows residents and visitors that Princeton is taking steps to welcome pets and help keep people and pets together.

The application includes demographics and an assessment of pet-friendliness in Princeton's shelters (in our case, rescue), homes, parks, and businesses. There is no cost to apply and you will receive a report on strengths, opportunities, and helpful resources. The assessment should be completed by someone in the city government or a designated partner, with the approval of the Mayor.

The completion of the assessment and certification would allow Ruff Start Rescue to be eligible for \$20,000 worth of grant funding each year to give us the means to support the Princeton community and their pets even further. I have attached a PDF version of the assessment questions for you to review. This assessment should not take more than an hour to complete.
