- Meetings Include the Student Voice, the President Voice, and the Industry Voice
- Agendas are Devoted to the Pillar Focus
 - This will require a disciplined approach to agenda planning, with many items not making the cut or being postponed to the appropriate month
- Committee Meetings are Focused on Preparing Items for the Upcoming Pillar
 - Committees identify which strategies and tactics they will accomplish for the upcoming year based on the pillar and will develop a
 one-year timeline and plan for discussion
