



IPEDS Graduation Rates

Graduation rates identify the percent of students from a cohort who graduated within a particular time period.

For degree-granting institutions, the cohort includes first-time, full-time students enrolled in the fall semester of a given school year. All degree-granting institutions except for Salt Lake Community College measure graduation rates from students who are seeking a bachelor's degree—the number of students who graduate with a bachelor's degree at four years (100% of time for a bachelor's degree), six years (150% of time for a bachelor's degree), and eight years (200% of time for a bachelor's degree). For SLCC, graduation rates are measured by the number of students who complete their program within 100%, 150%, and 200% of the time required for the program they completed. In 2012-13, Snow College began offering a limited number of four-year degrees. As such, IPEDS reclassified them as a four-year institution and thus reports graduation rates on the bachelor's degree-seeking cohorts. It should be noted that for the years observed herein, the cohort size is less than 10.

For technical colleges, the cohort includes first-time, full-time certificate-seeking students across an entire year (September 1 – August 31). Graduation rates measure the number of students who complete their program within 100%, 150%, and 200% of the time required for the program they completed.
