"Plumbing apprentice" is defined in RSA 153:27, XV, as amended pursuant to 2024, 284:1, effective September 24, 2024, which allows a master plumber to employ up to 2 apprentices per licensee and removes the requirement for master plumbers to register apprentice plumbers in an apprenticeship program pursuant to RSA 278.

The Mechanical Licensing Board (Board) proposes to readopt with amendment Mec 604.01 on misconduct as an interim rule pursuant to RSA 541-A:19, I(a) to implement amendments to RSA 153:27, XV to include plumbing apprentices who are not registered in an approved apprenticeship program pursuant to RSA 278.

The Board proposes to readopt with amendment Mec 605.02 on limiting the number of apprentices as an interim rule pursuant to RSA 541-A:19, I(a), to implement amendments to RSA 153:27, XV, to allow master plumbers to supervise a maximum of 2 apprentices who are not registered in a program pursuant to RSA 278.
