<p>Detailed cost of expenditure and timeline for project (Please include estimates and any other supporting documentation)</p>	<p>\$9,170.00 for 32 rifle-rated ballistic panels for a higher level of protection for tactical personnel. These panels will be used with existing carriers and weigh 3.6 pounds, offering better mobility during high-risk operations.</p>
<p>Narrative regarding expenditure (how this expenditure fits into the funding, how this expenditure will benefit the department/county, details regarding project, etc.)</p>	<p>As stated in the Final Rule, Recovery Funds can be used to support Public Safety and offer a much higher level of protection for tactical personnel that perform high-risk operations. In the current climate, more and more firearms are used in the commission of crimes and substantially more police officers are shot or killed during ambushes, raids, active intruders and other law enforcement operations.</p> <p>The current ballistic vests are not rated for rifle protection and are about to expire.</p> <p>32 panels will outfit our entire Joint Operation Team personnel, which includes Dixon Police Officers. Dixon PD is also considering a series of other expenditures for JOG through their funding mechanisms. This shared expense will allow the team to continue training and conduct operations while mitigating some of the risks associated with this type of mission.</p>

Only line item for this expenditure is for general bulletproof vest replacement for patrol deputies, which does not include tactical vests.</p>
