RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN:

Transform the student experience; Transform our own workforce experience; Create education without barriers through transformational partnerships; Redefine our value proposition through accessibility, affordability, quality, accountability, resource development, and operational excellence.

EXPLANATION:

The Drug-Free Schools and Communities Amendments Act of 1989 and regulations require the Colorado Community College System's Colleges to have a policy against the unlawful possession, use or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol. Additionally, the Colleges must adopt drug and alcohol abuse awareness programs, which include information to students about the dangers of drug and alcohol abuse, notice of sanctions if students are found in violation of this policy, and the resources available to students who are seeking help.

CCCS recently reviewed BP 19-30 as part of a scheduled review, and to ensure the policy and accompanying procedures are compliant with federal law and guidance.

The attached BP 19-30 reflects the non-substantive, editorial or conforming changes to the policy. A redline version showing the details of all revisions is available upon request.
