#### Findings: (2)

1) HR Clinical Staffing policies required updating.

• HR policies were updated.

2) Coverage for Medical Emergencies During and After Hours - our contracted provider after-hours call center response relating to translation services.

- The contracted after-hours provider trained their team and created a process flow to access the translation services.
- Documents addressing the findings were submitted to HRSA on 4/26/2024.

#### HRSA Compliance Resolution Opportunity (CRO):

- Process to correct/resolve any finding within 10 days of the Operational Site Visit preliminary report notification date from HRSA.
- Broward HealthPoint corrected and submitted documentation of the finding resolution on 4/26/24, well before the due date on 5/6/24.

#### HRSA Operational Site Visit Final Report

Received 5/16/24 - There were No Findings.





## **DATA AND BILLING**

- All FQHC billing transitioned to the Ambulatory Physician Billing and Coding Team.
- Developed and implemented standard operating procedures specific to FQHC Billing and Coding Requirements.
- Realized \$505K in enhanced reimbursement for Medicaid HMO Wrap Payments.
- Currently receiving enhanced reimbursement rates for all governmental payers (Medicare, Medicaid, Medicare HMO, Medicaid HMO).
