UCF's Compliance and Ethics Program was developed based on the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees contained in Part III, Chapter 112, Florida Statutes; the Federal Sentencing Guidelines Manual, Chapter 8, Part B, Section 2.1; and as required by the Florida Board of Governors Regulation 4.003. These requirements set forth an effective compliance and ethics program for organizations and require not only promoting compliance with laws, but also advancing a culture of ethical conduct.
