Former Alamosa mayor and longtime businesswoman Kathy (Rogers) Woods currently serves as economic development director for the City of Alamosa. Woods has served on multiple area boards including the Alamosa County Chamber of Commerce, the Upper Rio Grande Development Council, the Trinidad State College Foundation Membership, and the Adams State University Foundation Board. Woods is a member of the El Pomar San Luis Valley Regional Council.

Woods previously served on Alamosa City Council and as mayor for a combined total of 12 years. She served as president and CEO of Rio Grande Savings and Loan for three years. Prior to that position, she was vice president and director of development, marketing, foundation, customer service and operations for San Luis Valley Health for 14 years.
