Pursuant to Broward College Policy 6Hx2-1.14 and Procedure A6Hx2-1.14, Dr. Donald Astrab exercised the authority delegated by the Board to execute a standard agreement (purchase order) with Pearson VUE to purchase vouchers for the FDLE mandated State Officer Certification Exam for Basic Recruit Training at the Institute of Public Safety by utilizing bid waiver -educational materials. Fiscal Impact: Total Estimated cost of \$150,000.00.

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? FL State Law (F.S.S.943) mandates that every person admitted to a Basic Criminal Justice Officer Training Program must complete a "State Officer Certification Exam" at the end of a Basic Academy Training Program. Vouchers for the SOCE exams are ordered as needed and paid for by Broward College, then reimbursed by the sponsoring Law Enforcement Agency.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? FL DOE Rule 6A-14.0734(2)(a) Educational materials and suppliesand College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 provide exceptions to the competitive solicitation process for educational tests, textbooks, instructional materials and equipment, films, filmstrips, videotapes, disc or tape recordings, or similar audio-visual materials, graphic and computer-based instructional software. A bid waiver for Educational Materials and Supplies was used, where the exam is developed by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and is administered online by Pearson VUE, who has been designated as an approved vendor by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission/FDLE.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting

Yes, The funds are provided by the Tri-Party Testing Center.

What fund, cost center, and line item(s) were used? FD601, AG0186, GLC65000.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes. The contractor provided the same service in the FY 2023-2024.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes. The Institute of Public Safety has consistently provided this service since FDLE introduced the SOCE was to be administered online in 2014 at the conclusion of each academy. Positive feedback was received regarding the service provided.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? The ROI was anticipated when entering this contract by utilizing the convenience of service to our client agencies of Broward County.

Was that return on investment not met, met, or exceeded, and how? The ROI was Exceeded. The ability to administer the State Officer Certification Exam online for our client agencies leads to better outcomes in basic recruit training and the ability to have more officers serving our communities faster.
