#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize a standard agreement (purchase order) with Florida Organization of Associate Degree Nursing for membership and renewal dues for FY2024-2025. Fiscal Impact: \$75.00

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? The Florida Organization of Associate Degree Nursing (FOADN) provides a valuable platform for deans and directors of nursing programs to discuss and learn about the latest trends and issues impacting associate degree nursing education. Meeting four times a year allows for ongoing exchange of information and best practices. FOADN offers an opportunity to gain crucial insights and updates on state-mandated guidelines for nursing programs. This also ensures that the Broward College program remains compliant with all regulations and delivers the highest quality education to its students. Membership in FOADN fosters collaboration with other nursing program leaders across Florida. FOADN serves as a strong advocate for associate degree nursing programs at the state level. This membership ensures Broward College has a voice in shaping future policies and regulations that impact the program's direction and success.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. Membership dues, per the Florida Statute 119.01(3) requires that all financial, business and membership records held by the organization in relation to the individual(s) or organization(s) for whom a purchase order is being issued are to be considered public records and shall be subject to the provisions of Florida Statute 119.07.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting? Yes.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? FD100 CC0475 64502 Inst Memberships and Sponsorships.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Improved program quality will impact an NCLEX pass rate; in addition, an up-to-date curriculum with a latest trend in nursing will lead to higher enrollment and graduation rates, potentially increasing revenue for the college. Graduates with indemand skills may find jobs faster and command higher salaries, contributing to the local economy.

Was that return on investment not met, met, or exceeded and how? The return on investment for this contract was anticipated but not directly measured as the metrics are used by students passing the NCLEX exam. These factors impact increasing revenue for the college and contribute to the local economy as we deliver nurses in a field that is very short of this profession.

Does this directly or indirectly feed one of the Social Enterprise tactics and how? Yes, membership in the FOADN indirectly feeds into the Social Enterprise tactic of "Create Impactful Career Connections" in a few ways: By staying informed about current trends in the nursing field through FOADN meetings, the Broward College program can ensure its curriculum reflects the latest skills and knowledge demanded by employers. This directly translates to graduates with qualifications that are highly sought-after, making them more competitive in the job market. In addition, the FOADN's focus on improving associate degree nursing programs by providing essential tools in the academic setting impacting the delivery of graduates that are qualified to enter the workforce. This helps address the ongoing need for healthcare professionals in Florida, particularly as the population ages and demands on the healthcare system increase.

Did the vendor amend Broward College's legal terms and conditions [to be answered by the Legal Office] if the College's standard contract was used and was this acceptable to the Legal Office?

The General Counsel's office has reviewed the agreement and any deviation to the College's standard terms has been deemed acceptable.
